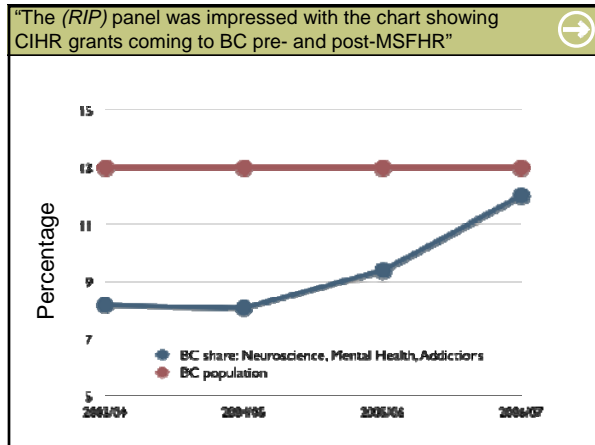

What do researchers want?

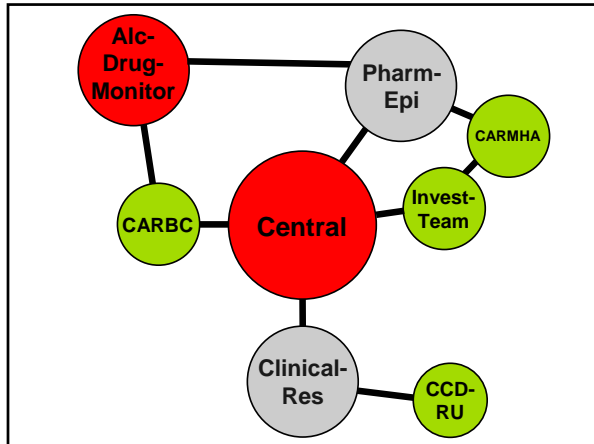

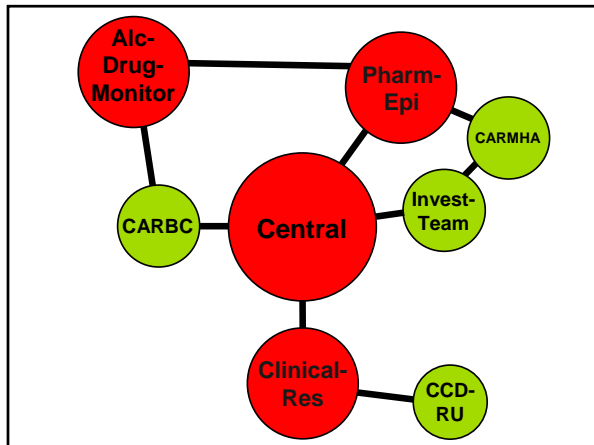
